

**WIZZ AIR ANNOUNCES THE NEW TURIN-BARI ROUTE
FOUR WEEKLY FREQUENCIES
STARTING FROM 18 DECEMBER 2020**

The airline debuts in the national segment from Turin

Caselle Torinese, October, 22, 2020 – Wizz Air, the main low cost airline in Central and Eastern Europe, today announces the expansion of its network from Turin with a new domestic route to and from Bari.

The flights will be operated from December,18, 2020 with 4 weekly frequencies (on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday) with fares starting from 9.99 euros *. Tickets are already on sale on www.wizzair.com.

To celebrate Wizz Air's expansion in Italy, the airline is launching an offer of 10,000 tickets for 1 euro** on its internal routes, bookable on wizzair.com only today 22 October 2020 for an unlimited travel period .

The schedule includes departure from Bari at 2:50PM and arrival in Turin at 4:30PM; the departure from Turin is instead scheduled at 5:05PM with arrival in the Apulian destination at 6:45PM.

"We are very satisfied with the launch of the new Turin-Bari route announced by Wizz Air, which marks the company's entrance into the market of domestic connections from our airport. This is yet another confirmation of the fact that the national segment is the one showing the greatest demand for air transport during the crisis linked to the spread of COVID-19 - commented Andrea Andorno, CEO of Torino Airport -. We are also confident that this choice will lead to further development of Wizz Air in Turin in the coming years".

The network of Wizz Air from Turin thus increases: the new ski-route to St. Petersburg will make its debut on December 19th, announced in the summer. In the winter season 2020-2021 there will be therefore 6 destinations on the Wizz Air network from Torino Airport: in addition to Bari and St. Petersburg, the carrier will also connect Piedmont with Tirana (in Albania), Bacau and Bucharest (in Romania), and for winter Warsaw (in Poland). From April 2021, Chisinau (in Moldova) will also be added to the network.
